### 1. Paper Presentation

#### **Rules and Regulations**

1. Maximum number of participants in a Team is 2.
2. The topics that the papers can be chosen by your own. It is advisable that the presentation focuses on one particular topic.
3. Paper should be in IEEE format and not exceeding 5 pages.
4. Paper must contain figures, tables, abstract, Introduction, description of subject, conclusion, result and references.
5. Paper should contain Title of the paper, Names of the author, Name of the College, Phone number of the authors and email id.
6. Soft-copy of the submitted paper must be in the .doc format.
7. Kindly mail your full paper to [it@avccengg.net](mailto:it@avccengg.net). Two days prior to the symposium send your presentation to the above said mail.
8. The time limit for the paper presentation is 10 minutes (8 minutes for presentation and 2 minutes for queries).
9. The decision of judges will be final and no arguments or appeal will be entertained.

### 2. Technical Quiz

#### **Rules and Regulations**

- Only Individuals are allowed to participate in this event.
- Electronic gadgets such as mobile phones, pagers, tabs, laptops, etc., should not be used in the competition.
- **PRELIMINARY FIRST ROUND – 20 Mins**
  - This round is aimed to filter maximum of 10 members for the next round.
  - 20 questions will be given to each team of the technical quiz event.

- The time duration for this round is 20 minutes only.
- The top 10 members from this round are eligible for the next round.
- **FINAL TECHNICAL ROUND – 10Mins**
  - 10 questions will be given to each Individual technical quiz event.
  - The time duration for this round is 5 mins only.
  - The top 3 Individual from this round will be prize winners.

#### **Rules and Regulations**
